March 22/23, 2014: 3rd Sunday of Lent

3rd Sunday of Lent: Exodus 17:3-7; Psalm 95; Romans 5:1-2, 5-8; John 4:5-42

The sun beat mercilessly from its midday apex. Moisture rose from the ground, as if trying to escape, but the sunshine greedily lapped it up. Most people were in the shade at this hour, but not her; she was on her way to draw water from the well. It was much easier to carry the jar back home during the cool of the morning. For her, this meant jeers and menacing glares from the other women who went to the well too. "There's the one who can't keep a husband. She's already had five," they'd say as she passed by, "I wonder what's wrong with her? " Normally she endured their abuse without protest. Last time, though, had been different. Some shepherds had spotted her heading back from the well. They stalked her all the way home, teasing her with catcalls. She had a thick skin to such words, but the fact that they had followed her for so long was unsettling. Better to be careful, so today she made the trek alone in the noonday heat.

She met no one on the path, just as she'd hoped, so the sight of the figure leaning against the well startled her. He had already spotted her. If she turned around now, he would know she was afraid. She kept walking with purpose, as though she meant to go somewhere beyond the well. She tensed up walking past the well. "Give me a drink," said the man. She cursed under her breath. Of course the water-jar she held had tipped him off. Racking her mind, she grasped for any reason not to go near the man. "How is it that you, a Jew, ask a drink of me, a woman of Samaria?" she said nervously. "If you knew who had said this to you, you would have asked him, and he would have given you living water." She looked at the man quizzically. "Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again," he said, pointing at the well, "but those who drink of the water that I will give them will never be thirsty." "Sir, give me this water so that I never have come back to this awful place!" she blurted out, surprised at the emotion of her own words. She was not prepared for the man's look of understanding—it had been so long since someone had spoken to her like a person. He kept standing by her as she choked back the tears, even as his puzzled friends joined him. She walked back to town processing the encounter. She was so stunned she had forgotten her jar. She had to tell the others about the man who had known everything about her and had still stood by her.


