

the church is no longer mandatory, but is strongly recommended.



The general dispensation from Sunday Mass WINNIPEG will not be renewed at this time. Keeping contact lists will no longer be required. For the comfort of all, attendees should self-screen before arriving at Mass for any symptoms of COVID-19. If people are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, they should refrain from coming to Mass.

Please note the following updates to Liturgical **Protocols:**

- 1. Weekday and Sunday Masses can return to normal with no capacity restrictions. Masks are strongly recommended indoors for Masses and any meetings or gatherings within our building.
- 2. Parishes are encouraged to continue live-streaming of Mass to benefit members of the community who are shut-in or in personal care homes. St. John Brebeuf will continue to live-stream our Sunday 10am Mass via the parish website: www.sjbcommunity.ca
- 3. Hand sanitizing stations will remain in place.
- 4. Collection Procedures may resume to prepandemic practice.
- 5. Offertory Processions can be re-instated to prepandemic practice.
- 6. Celebrations of First Communions, Baptisms, Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick, Marriages and Funerals return to normal with no capacity restrictions.
- 7. Celebration of Confirmation can be celebrated with no capacity restrictions. The Archbishop will resume celebrating Confirmation in parishes after the celebration of Easter.
- 8. The **Sign of Peace** will continue to be expressed with a head bow toward others in the assembly.
- Communion Processions can return without physical distancing.
- 10. The Distribution of Communion returns to prepandemic practice with the exception that the communion cup will not be offered and receiving Communion on the hand will be the general practice.
- 11. Holy Water fonts may be filled and used.

The bishops of Manitoba will be meeting in the coming weeks to discuss further developments, and additional announcements will follow.

Standing up to corporate power in Honduras



The *People and Planet First* campaign is about helping communities stand up to corporate power.

In Honduras, as in much of the Global South, corporations often threaten and criminalize activists who speak up against their abuses.

The Lenca Indigenous leader Víctor Vásquez was imprisoned for fighting the corporate takeover of his people's ancestral territory. Development and Peace's partner, the Honduran Centre for the Promotion of Community Development (CEHPRODEC), helped free him from jail.

Another partner, Caritas Choluteca, trains and accompanies community leaders in advocating for policies that respect human rights and the environment. Recently, they got mayoral election candidates to undertake to declare the municipality of Orocuina a mining-free zone if elected.
