



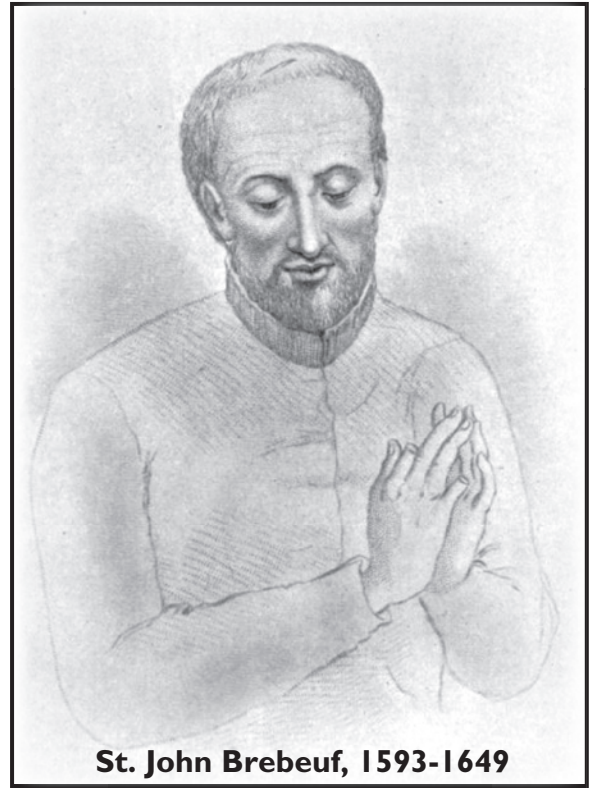

Archdiocese of Winnipeg Synod Implementation

Global Initiative #3

“We encourage all the baptized to acquire familiarity with Sacred Scripture.”

This Lent, as part of the implementation of our Archdiocesan Synod, we are invited to connect with family and friends in a very special way using *Lectio Divina* or “Breaking open the Word.” This ancient method of praying with sacred texts dates to the fourth century. The four simple steps of *Lectio Divina*: reading, meditation, prayer and contemplation take about 20 minutes.

Lectio Made Simple For Families

- Settle in a cozy spot.
- Read the Sunday Gospel, slowly, 2 or even 3 times. (encourage children to use their imagination– “Can you see yourself in the story?”)
- One of the following questions can be discussed after each reading of the scripture passage. (Allow everyone to speak.)
- Encourage a response. “What did you like in the story?”
- God speaks to us through this story. “What do you think God is saying?” Listen deeply.
- “What might God be asking you to do?”
- Close with the Our Father. Share a healthy treat.

St. John Brebeuf Parish offers this ancient method of praying with sacred texts Monday afternoons, from the fall months through the spring. Please refer to the bulletin calendar, noting that dates are subject to change.
