CHRISTIAN OUTREACH AT ST. JOHN BREBEUF PARISH



REST IN PEACE


Your prayers are requested for Father Emmett McKenna, who died peacefully in the late afternoon of May 1, 2011 at René Goupil House, Pickering. He was in the 91st year of his life and a Jesuit for 69 years.

He was ordained a priest on June 19, 1949 at Martyrs' Shrine, Midland. In the decades to follow, Fr. McKenna taught at universities and high schools in Ontario, Nova Scotia, Quebec and Manitoba, including a ten year posting at St. Paul's High School in Winnipeg, where he was minister, teacher, assistant prefect of discipline, and for three years, a principal. From 1977 to 1982, Fr. McKenna ministered at St. John Brebeuf Parish.

A Funeral Mass was held May 5 at Manresa Retreat House, Pickering, Ont. May he rest in peace.
