Suspension of Faith Gatherings:

As announced Friday, May 7 by the Provincial Government, effective Sunday, May 9, 2021, all Faith Gatherings, including Mass, were suspended. **The celebrations of weddings, funerals and baptisms are permitted, with a maximum of ten (10) attendees.** The restrictions will be in place until at least May 30, 2021.

The Parish Office remains closed to the public. All messages are returned as soon as possible.

From Archbishop Gagnon:

The current general dispensation from Sunday Mass concludes May 23, 2021. Taking into consideration the current state of the pandemic this general dispensation is now extended until Sunday, July 4, 2021.

The media can promote values that lead to a more fully human society. The Church's ministry is twofold. The media can be used to promote the Gospel. 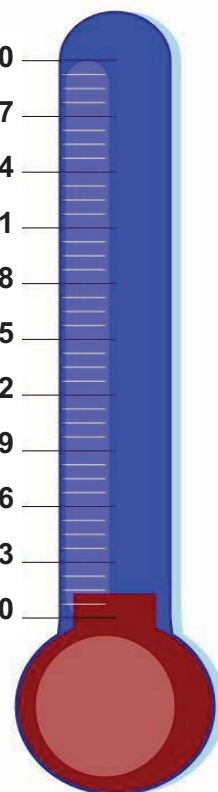
