



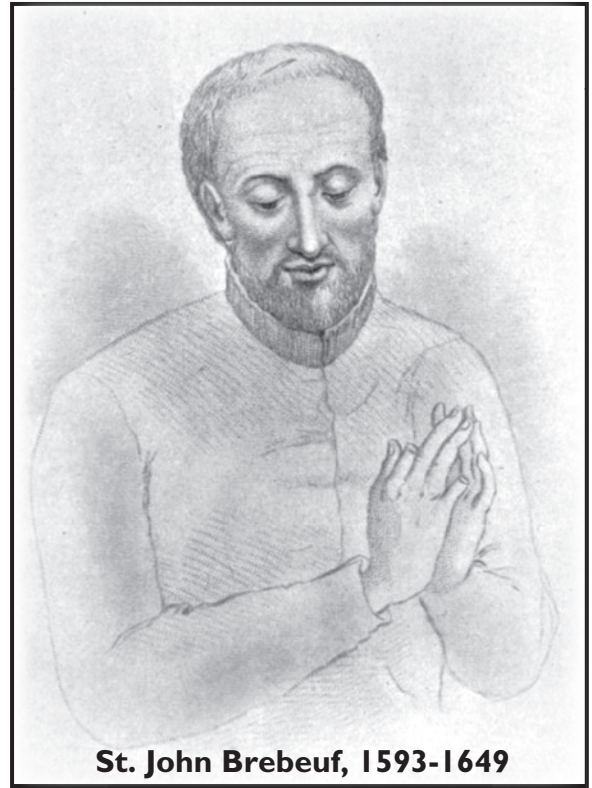

Pope's Pastoral Works:

Next weekend, May 25 & 26, a collection for the Pope's Pastoral Works will be taken up during the offertory collection. A dedicated envelope is included in your offertory envelope box, or can be found at all church entrances. This collection provides an opportunity for Catholics to make a financial offering to assist the Holy Father. One-third of the funds collected is for what is traditionally known as Peter's Pence: donations used by the Pope for his charitable contributions for those most in need. Two-thirds of the collection is to support the Holy Father in administering the Holy See and serving the Universal Church (Canon 1271).

Pilgrim Queen of the Family

The Pilgrim Queen Home Shrine is a simple wooden triptych with the iconic image of Our Lady of Guadalupe as its centrepiece; flanked by a rosary and the four sets of Mysteries on one side, and a pledge to dutifully pray the Rosary on the other. It comes with a Guide of prayers and meditations that help us to focus on Our Lady's prayers, and is an effective means of facilitating family prayer; specifically the praying of the Rosary, and the fostering of devotion to Mary.
