



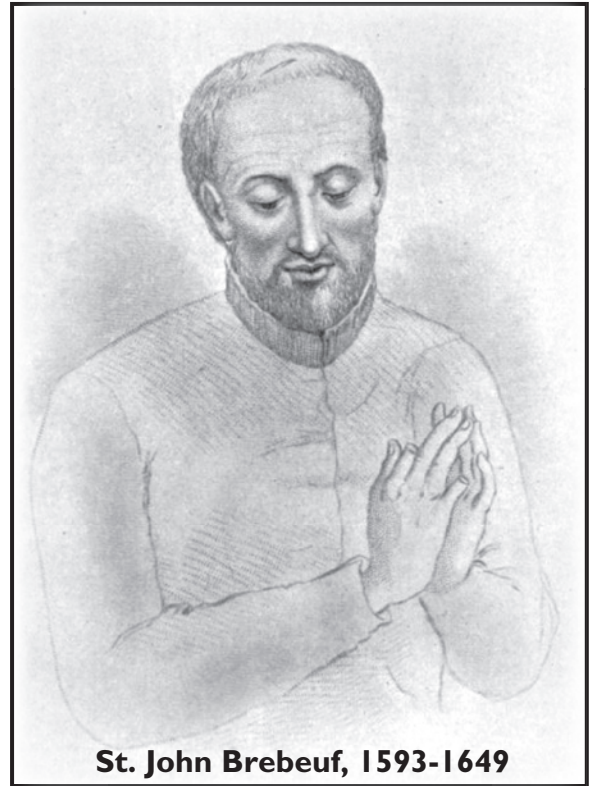

Updated Restrictions for In-Person Masses:
Entry and exit for all Masses via John Brebeuf Place only. The door will be open 15 minutes prior to Masses.

As of April 28 maximum capacity for faith-based gatherings has been reduced to **ten (10) people.** **Reservations are required for weekend Masses.** They are accepted starting on Mondays until capacity is reached: parishoffice@sjbcommunity.ca or 204-488-4467 (Ext. 210). **We will not accept bookings beyond the current week.**

Celebration of Weddings, Funerals, and Baptisms are also limited to ten (10) people.

Do not come to Mass if you are feeling ill, particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.

Please sign in (weekdays) or check in with the door greeter weekends when you enter the church.

Please **sanitize your hands** as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **social distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building.

Please **leave your offering in the designated basket** at the main church aisle when you enter the worship space.

Please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews. Unless you have come as a family unit, individual distancing of six feet (2 meters) within pews is required.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please **exit as soon as Mass ends** without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well being of all.

The Parish Office remains closed to the public until further notice. All emails and phone messages will be returned as soon as possible. If we do not have your current contact information, please email or call so that we can update our parish records.

From the Archdiocese:

A February 24 memorandum from Archbishop Gagnon regarding the pandemic stated that: "Taking into consideration the current state of the pandemic, ***the dispensation from the Sunday obligation to attend Mass is now extended until Pentecost Sunday, May 23, 2021***".
