



### **Pope's Pastoral Works:**

Next weekend, May 20/21, a collection for the Pope's Pastoral Works will be taken up during the offertory collection. A dedicated envelope is included in your offertory envelope box, or can be



found at all church entrances. This collection provides an opportunity for Catholics to make a financial offering to assist the Holy Father. One-third of the funds collected is for what is traditionally known as Peter's Pence: donations used by the Pope for his charitable contributions for those most in need. Two-thirds of the collection is to support the Holy Father in administering the Holy See and serving the Universal Church (Canon 1271).
