



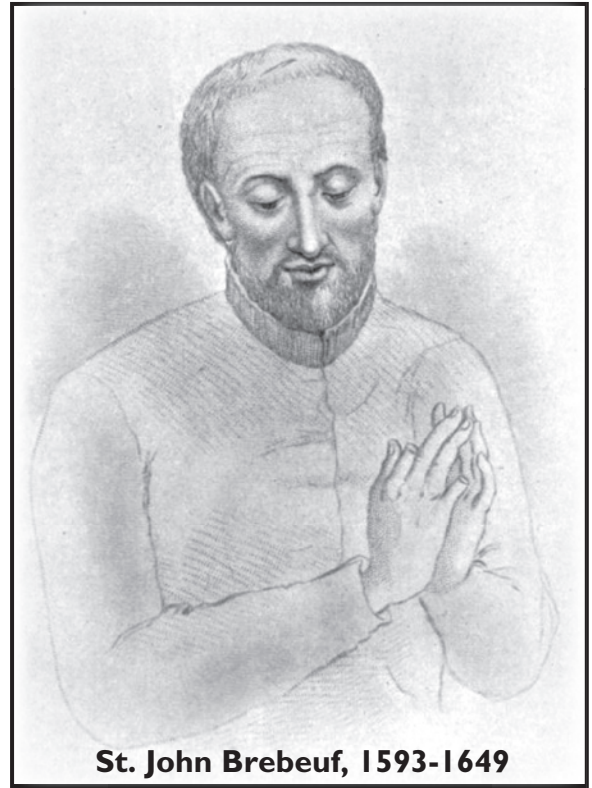



2022 Spring Edition of *On the Way* is Available Digitally!

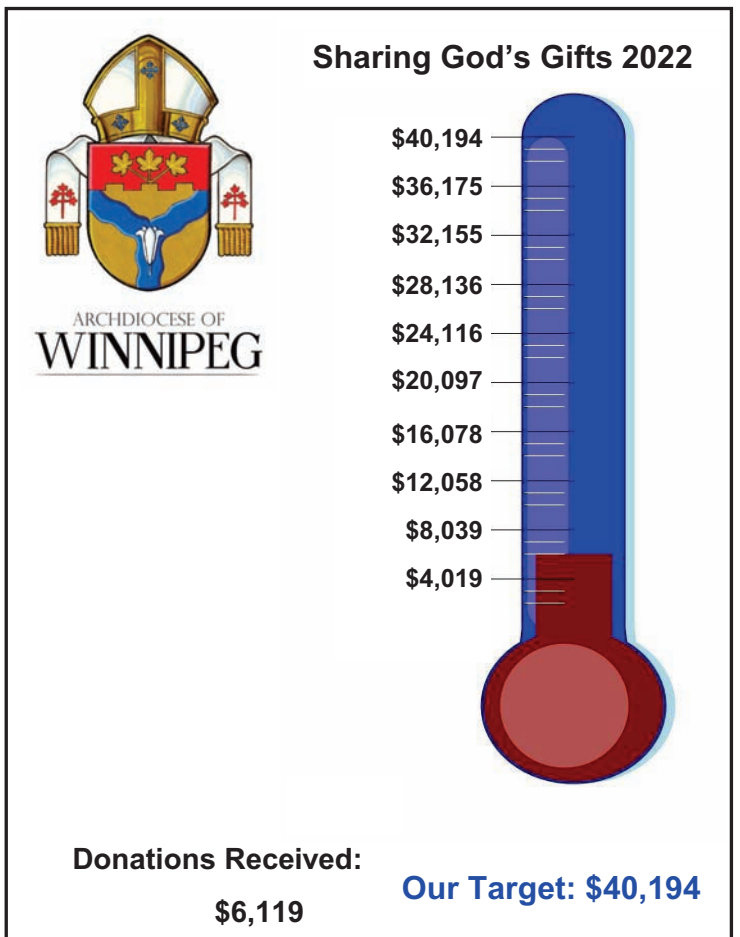
We are pleased to publish the 2022 Spring edition of *On the Way*, a publication of the Archdiocese of Winnipeg.
