

Good news! Our regular Mass schedule resumes on Tuesday, June 2. You will see many changes when you come to Church. All of them are to keep us safe in the age of pandemic. Maintaining provincial standards of social distancing will be of prime importance. Many aids in the Church are there to help.

There will be only one entrance to the Church and the same is used to exit. A monitor at the door will keep track of the number of people in the Church and will be of assistance in avoiding crowding at the door. You will find a number of hand sanitizer stations inside the entrance well-spaced to avoid crowding. Everyone is asked to use the hand sanitizer generously.

Only a certain number of pews will be available for seating. They are set up this way to maintain physical distance and to facilitate the sanitizing of pews after every mass.

Communion from the cup, and on the tongue will not be offered. The sign of peace will be a simple bow instead of the usual handshake.

Please do not stop to chat in the vestibule on the way out, but proceed immediately through the exit after mass. Social time is more appropriate outside the Church in the open air.

You will find the number of people in the Church lower than you usually see. The number of people allowed in the building depends on provincial health regulations and I think we can expect that number to rise significantly in the near future, but we can't take it for granted yet. In our situation, a number of variables determine permissible occupancy. I can't give you a precise number at this point but hope to very soon; certainly before Tuesday.

If you feel ill with flu or cold-like symptoms, please don't come to Church. Seek medical help. The elderly and people with long-term health issues might want to wait a little longer before coming back to Church. Archbishop Gagnon has dispensed all the faithful in his care from the Sunday obligation through Sunday, September 6, 2020. Stay safe by practicing spiritual communion at home.

I don't know of anyone who has suffered from the virus in our parish. I thank God for that, and I pray this blessing will continue. Restrictions to the practice of our faith of any kind are difficult to bear, but we accept them for the good of all and pray we can return to life we know and love very soon.
