

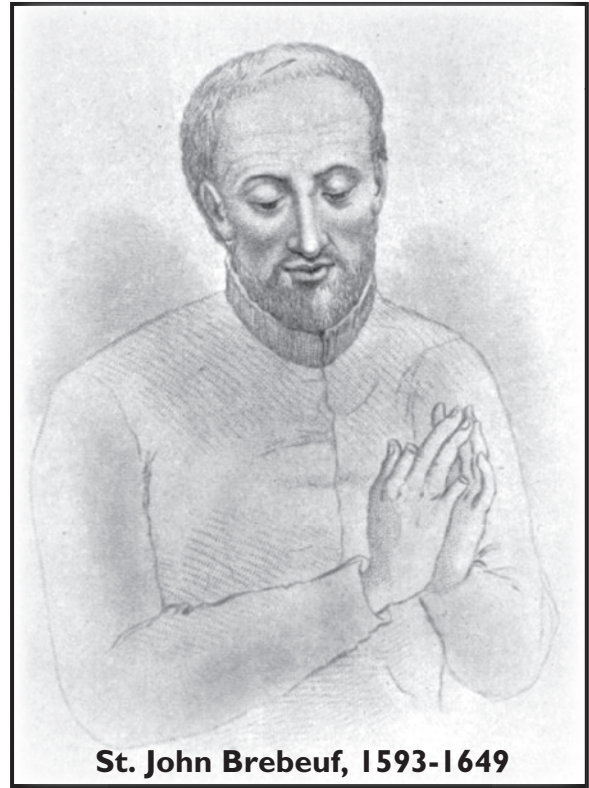

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament with Benediction: Every Friday at 8:15am.
