

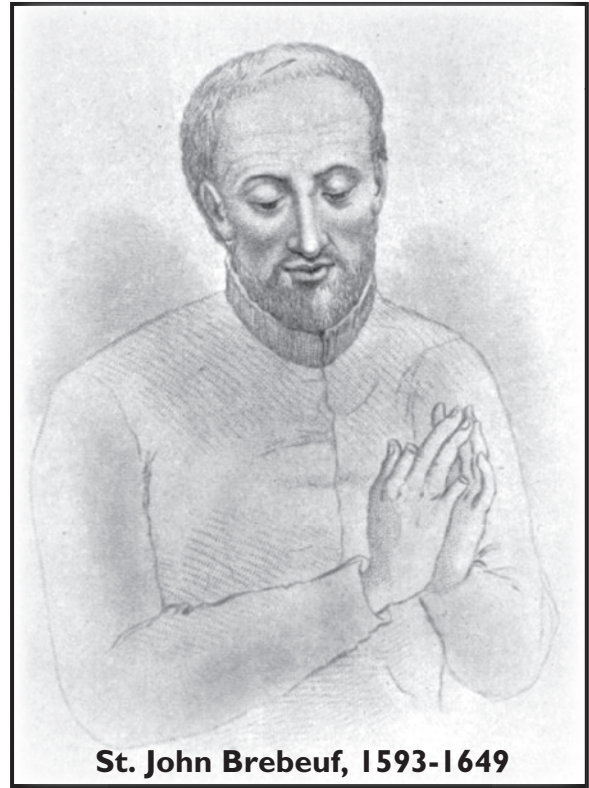

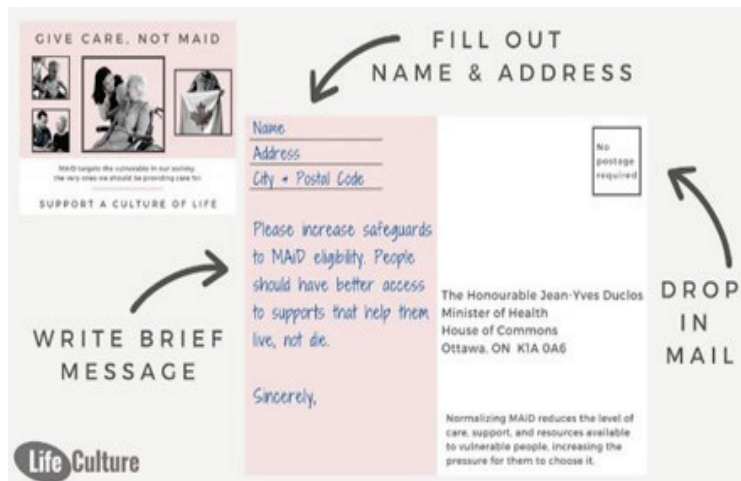


Tri-diocesan liturgy to celebrate the National Week for Life and the Family – May 9, 2023
