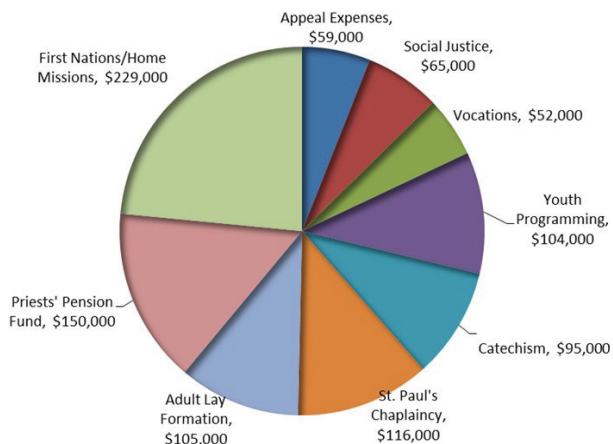
2019 Sharing God's Gifts: Where Does my Donation Go?
