

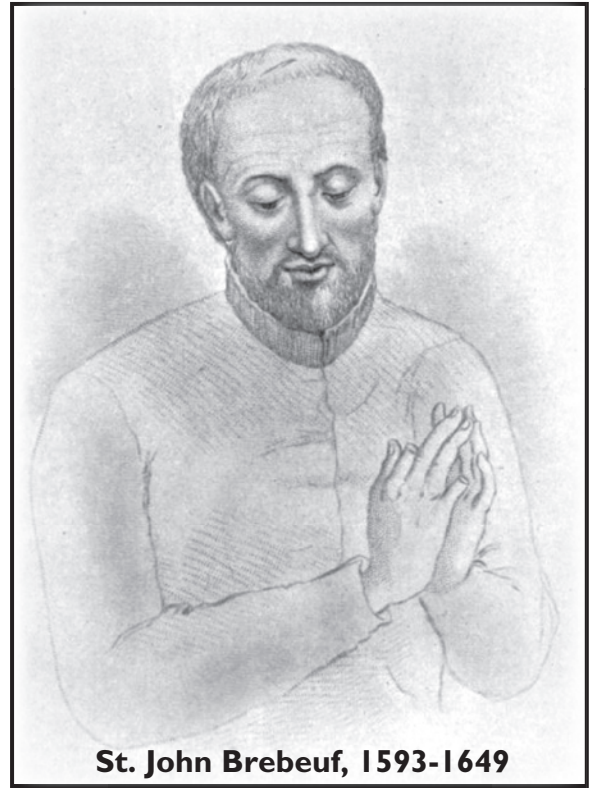

Book of Remembrance

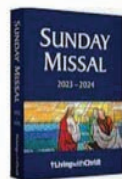


You are invited to inscribe the names of your deceased relatives and friends in our **Memorial Book of Remembrance**, which will be located at the front of the church.

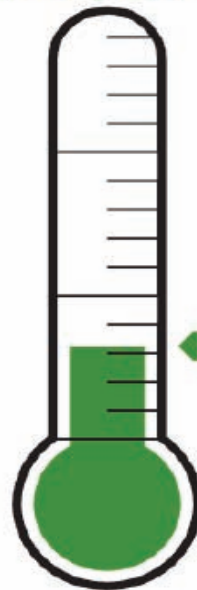
