Mass Intentions:

Please note that there are no Mass Intentions available for the remainder of 2016. Mass requests for the rest of the year can be sent away to a rural parish. Please visit the Parish Office to arrange for this.



Due to the large number of people requesting that Masses be celebrated on Sunday, and those requesting multiple Masses per year:

- Saturday or Sunday Masses will not be assigned to either an individual donor or an individual intention more often than once every three months. Weekday Mass Intentions are limited to one every month.
- If you have a special date, it is best to request your intentions several months in advance.
- Mass dates are subject to change. In the event of a cancellation, we will do our best to reschedule the intention at the earliest available date.
- From time to time, we may need to send booked Mass intentions to our country priests to ensure that Mass is being celebrated in a timely manner.
- The stipend for each requested Mass Intention is \$10.00, payable when the Mass is booked.
