


Catholic Women's League: Information will be shared through emails and calls.

Updated COVID-19 Public Gathering Restrictions as of November 12, 2020 (Code Red):

As of 12:01am Thursday, November 12, 2020, all churches, chapels and mission places of worship are to suspend all public services for a period of at least four (4) weeks or until further notice.

Therefore, all public services at St. John Brebeuf Parish are cancelled until further notice.

The celebration of funeral Masses is permitted within the provincial restriction of five (5) people in attendance.

Also during the Code Red Restrictions, the Parish Office is closed until further notice.

Children's Faith Formation 2020-2021 (Online Format):

Online classes began Sunday, October 18 and will continue as per the schedule (available at www.sjbcommunity.ca). Please note that:

- Grades 4 to 6 start time will change to **Noon to 12:30pm** to accommodate families with more than one child.
- The scheduled class time for the other grades remains at **11:30am to Noon**.

Registrations are still being accepted for the 2020-2021 year at <u>http://www.sjbcommunity.ca/faith-formation/</u> Registered students will receive a Pflaum booklet and will be working with online resources, crafts and fun activities at home. A catechist will contact you to provide an online link for the classes.

1st Reconciliation/1st Eucharist:

Parents of children in grade 2 who have not registered are asked to register online at www.sjbcommunity.ca as soon as possible for the Sacramental preparation for 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. This year, parent meetings will be held online, and books will be provided by the parish. Candidates will be asked to sign up for a one-on-one 1st Reconciliation with Fr Wayne on one of three Saturday's during Lent. There will be in-person rehearsal and the Sacrament of 1st Eucharist will take place in the spring. Please watch the parish bulletin and website for a list of important dates, available soon.

Sacrament of Confirmation:

Parents of children in Grade 8 (and those in higher grades who have not yet received the Sacrament of Confirmation) are asked to register online at www.sjbcommunity.ca for preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Classes will be held online this year, with books provided by the parish. There will be in-person rehearsal and Confirmation Mass next spring. The Dying Healed Program (Nov. 23, 30 & Dec 7, 7pm to 8:30pm / online) prepares the average person


