





### November4/5, 2017: 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time

#### Information on the Synod of the Archdiocese of Winnipeg

For the first time in its history, the Archdiocese of Winnipeg is conducting a Synod. Archbishop Gagnon began the Synod on Pentecost 2016 and announced his intention to close it on Pentecost 2018. The preparatory phase of the Synod has been completed. It began with work by a General Preparatory Commission which organized listening sessions throughout the archdiocese to which all Catholics were invited. Next, various commissions prepared recommendations for the Synod delegates to consider; these recommendations were based upon the listening sessions. The areas covered are Vocations and Leadership; Marriage and Family; Catechetics and Faith Development; Social Outreach; Church Governance; Indigenous People; New Evangelization and Missionary Outreach; Sacramental Preparation, Prayer and Devotional Life; Youth and Young Adults.

In September, 2017, Synod Delegates attended orientation sessions. On November 4, 2017 the Synod held its first General Session. Five further sessions will be held through to April 21, 2018.

The main objective of a diocesan synod is to discover what is known as the *sensus fidelium*, "the sense/ perception of Christ's Faithful." While synod delegates have clergy and religious among their number, the bulk of the delegates come from the various parishes in the archdiocese: two delegates from each larger parish and one from each of the smaller parishes. Together, the delegates will seek to discern how the Holy Spirit is at work in our archdiocesan church in this particular time. Through discerning the movement of the Holy Spirit, it is hoped that the Synod will offer the archdiocesan church a plan for its pastoral mission, a plan guided and inspired by the Holy Spirit.

At each session, the Synod will consider propositions offered by the various commissions. For example, in the area of Marriage and Family Life, three propositions were offered: that : 1) we establish a resource Centre for Marriage and Family Life; 2) we educate clergy, seminarians and pastoral workers on recognizing and ministering to "irregular/unconventional/alternative" family situations; 3) we uphold the role of marriage and the family life as a vocation. Delegates will have pondered and prayed over the various propositions prior to each general session. Then, at the session, propositions will be discussed. Following discussion, votes will be conducted. To be adopted, a proposition must receive the support of at least 2/3 of the delegates.

The lay delegates from our parish are Margaret Kingdon and Johnston Smith. Our pastor, Fr. Morrissey, has also been named as a clerical delegate. We hope to keep parishioners informed on the Synod's activities over the ensuing months. One of the ways of doing this will be postings on the SJB parish website: www.sjbcommunity.ca

All parishioners can participate in the Synod through your prayers. Following is the official Synod Prayer:

Look upon us your children whom You have established and anointed in Christ your Son.

As we enter our second century as a community of faith, we desire to be more and more conformed to Christ.

Help us to find our identity and mission in:

Jesus – the Priest who sanctifies

Jesus – the Prophet who teaches the ways of God

Jesus – the King who shepherds and lays down his life for his sheep.

Send your Holy Spirit upon us so that, confident of Christ's love and our union with Him, we may be true missionary disciples,

His light in the world today.

We ask this through Christ, Our Lord. Amen
