

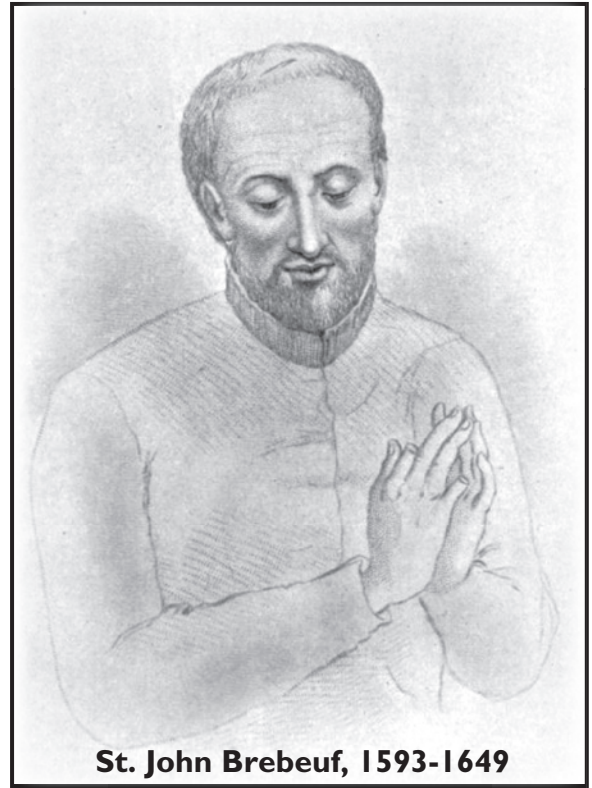

Catholic Women's League: Meets at 11:00am on the first Sunday of the month (October to May)..

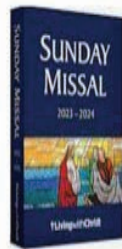
