

#### From Archbishop Gagnon:

We are all aware that the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic continue. In light of this: the dispensation from the Sunday obligation to attend Mass is granted to the faithful through January 1, 2021. Obviously this could change depending on circumstances.

#### **Attending Masses at St. John Brebeuf:**

Entry and exit for all Masses via John Brebeuf Place only. The door will be open 30 minutes prior to weekend Masses, and 15 minutes prior to weekday Masses.

Current maximum capacity is 100 people.

Reservations are no longer needed but <u>masks are now</u> required.

Do not come to Mass or visit the Parish Office if you are feeling ill, particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.

Please note that there is **no Morning Prayer or Rosary** at this time.

Please sign in (preferably with your own pen) when you enter the church. One name per line, please.

Please sanitize your hands as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **social distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building.

For Masses in the church, please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews. Unless you have come as a family unit, individual distancing of six feet (2 meters) within pews is required.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please leave your offering in the designated basket at the main church aisle when you enter for Mass.

Please exit as soon as Mass ends without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well being of all.

#### 1st Reconciliation/1st Eucharist:


Parents of children in grade 2 who have not registered are asked to register online at www.sjbcommunity.ca as soon as possible for the Sacramental preparation for 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. This year, parent meetings will be held online, and books will be provided by the parish. Candidates will be asked to sign up for a one-on-one 1st Reconciliation with Fr Wayne on one of three Saturday's during Lent. There will be in-person rehearsal and the Sacrament of 1st Eucharist will take place in the spring. Please watch the parish bulletin and website for a list of important dates, available soon.

Parents of children in Grade 8 (and those in higher grades who have not yet received the Sacrament of Confirmation) are asked to register online at www.sibcommunity.ca for preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. 
#### **Development and Peace:**

#### From the Archdiocese:

Effective Monday, November 2, the pandemic response level in the Winnipeg Metropolitan Health Region was elevated to **Red** (Critical). Faith Gatherings, including Mass, are restricted to a maximum of 15% occupancy, or 100, whichever is lower. St. John Brebeuf's maximum occupancy changes to 100 people. Restrictions continue for indoor and outdoor gatherings with a limit of five (5) people for weddings, funerals, baptisms and other special events.
