


**Catholic Women's League:** Information will be shared through emails and calls.

#### Attending Masses at St. John Brebeuf:

Entry and exit for all Masses via John Brebeuf Place only. The door will be open 30 minutes prior to Masses.

Current maximum capacity is 200 people.

Reservations are no longer required but <u>masks are now</u> <u>mandatory</u>.

Do not come to Mass or visit the Parish Office if you are feeling ill, particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.

Please note that there is **no Morning Prayer or Rosary** at this time.

**Please sign in** (preferably with your own pen) when you enter the church.

Please sanitize your hands as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **social distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building.

For Masses in the church, **please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews**. Unless you have come as a family unit, individual distancing of six feet (2 meters) within pews is required.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please **leave your offering in the designated basket** at the main church aisle when you enter for Mass.

Please **exit as soon as Mass ends** without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well being of all.

# Children's Faith Formation 2020-2021 UPDATES!

This term (October-December 2020) our Children's Catechism program (Grades 1 to 8) will be offered <u>online</u>. **Classes will be held Sunday's from 11:30am to Noon, starting October 18**. Registered students will receive a Pflaum booklet and will be working with online resources, crafts and fun activities at home. A catechist will contact you to provide an online link for the classes. Given the ever-changing circumstances due to the COVID-19 pandemic, by the end of this year we will re-evaluate our options for the January-April 2021 term: continue online or return to in-person classes. Parents' input will be appreciated and factored into this decision.

#### 1st Reconciliation/1st Eucharist:

Parents of children in grade 2 are asked to register online at www.sjbcommunity.ca for the Sacramental preparation for 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. This year, parent meetings will be held online, and books will be provided by the parish. Candidates will be asked to sign up for a one-on-one 1st Reconciliation with Fr Wayne on one of three Saturday's during Lent. There will be in-person rehearsal and the Sacrament of 1st Eucharist will take place in the spring. Please watch the parish bulletin and website for a list of important dates, available soon.

#### Sacrament of Confirmation:

Parents of children in Grade 8 (and those in higher grades who have not yet received the Sacrament of Confirmation) are asked to register online at www.sjbcommunity.ca for preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Classes will be held online this year, with books provided by the parish. There will be in-person rehearsal and Confirmation Mass next spring. A list of important dates will be provided soon on the parish website.

# Our Cross Comes Home...

Over the past several months, St. John Brebeuf Church undertook an extensive construction project that included extensive roof work, interior church flooring, interior and exterior apse repair, and restoration and recladding of our cross. This week, our cross came home to it's rightful place atop our church building.



New stainless steel cladding, as well as jointing welds and details make our cross more substantial than the original.



On Wednesday, October 7, the cross was transported to the church on a flat bed truck to an awaiting crane.



Once lifted into place, the refurbished cross was lowered into it's bracket and safely secured.
