From Father Mark:

A few little 'housekeeping' details from Father Mark:

+ When we come forward to receive the Body of Christ at Holy Communion that each person is to bow before we receive communion. This is a moment in which we prepare and remember who it is that we receive.

+I know that parking can be frustrating at Saint John Brebeuf and at times people arrive late. I would again very humbly ask that as you come into Mass that you choose a time to find a place to sit when there is a pause, after the opening prayer or even between the readings. This allows one to be a little more discreet and to not take attention away from the prayers or the Word.

+During study days the priests of the Archdiocese heard an expert in marketing remind us that on any given day a person is exposed to 2000 advertisements. This has a lot to do with the handheld devices most of us have. With this in mind I humbly ask that these devices are not used within the Church worship space at any time. Texting in the sacred space somewhat makes ordinary the extraordinary place in which we encounter the Body of Christ.

Please accept these as they are meant, a reminder that even the Pastor needs to read!
