OCTOBER 15/16 2011 TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The Roman Missal: The invitation to the memorial acclamation has changed. Instead of the priest interrupting the Eucharistic Prayer with an admonition or instruction addressed to the assembly (*Let us proclaim the mystery of faith*), he will simply say: *The mystery of faith*. This matches the Latin: *Mysterium fidei*. The familiar first form of the acclamation: *Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again*, has never been in the Latin edition of the Roman Missal, and therefore, will not be found in the new English edition. Instead, the fuller Latin text has been freshly translated and included: *We proclaim your Death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection, until you come again*.

The other two acclamations have likewise been retranslated as follows:

When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim your Death, O Lord, until you come again. Save us, Saviour of the world, for by your Cross and Resurrection you have set us free.

During the Communion Rite there is a notable change (to match the Latin text) in the invitation which the priest extends and in the assembly's response:

Priest: *Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world: Blessed are those called to the Supper of the Lamb.*
All: *Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.*

The priest's text echoes the words of John the Baptist (John 1.29) and the words from the Book of Revelation 19.9. The assembly's response echoes the words of the Roman Centurion, found in Matthew 8.8.

Celebrate in Song: To prepare for the new translation of the Roman Missal, St. John Brebeuf Parish has purchased *Celebrate in Song*, a complete guide to the new Order of Mass and music. Books will be available in the pews for the use of parishioners during Masses. Those wishing to purchase personal copies can do so at the Parish Office for \$5.00/book.

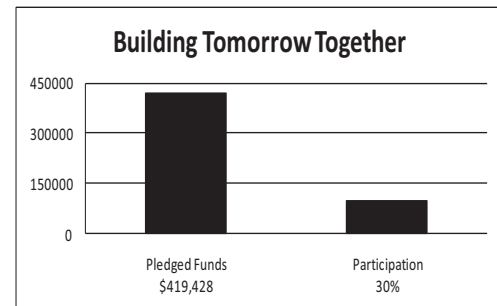
