

## Sacraments of 1<sup>st</sup>. Reconciliation and 1<sup>st</sup> Eucharist


In the St. John Brebeuf community, children celebrate their first reconciliation and first Eucharist in grade two. Parents prepare their children for these sacraments with materials and resources provided by the parish. We begin with an orientation for parents and candidates.

## Sacrament of Confirmation

Confirmation is conferred in grade 8 to baptized children who are in full communion (receiving Eucharist) at St. John Brebeuf. We begin preparation in the fall with an orientation meeting for candidates.

## Share the Word: (Ages 3-5) No pre-registration required

Share the Word is Liturgy of the Word for 3-5 year-old children during 10:00 a.m. Sunday Mass from the fall into the spring season. At the beginning of Mass, Father Wayne says a prayer over the children before they go to the school library to learn about the Gospel of the day and participate in a corresponding craft.
