

While in the church, Physical Distancing and the Use of Masks Is Required.

A Reminder that all protocols are still in place!

Do not come to Mass if you are feeling ill, particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.

Please sanitize your hands as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **physical distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building. **The Use of Masks is required in the church.**

Please **leave your offering in the designated basket** at the main church aisle when you enter the worship space.

Please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews. Unless you have come as a family unit, individual distancing of six feet (2 meters) within pews is required.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please **exit as soon as Mass ends** without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well-being of all.

Sacrament of 1st Reconciliation/1st Eucharist:

In the St. John Brebeuf community, children celebrate their first Reconciliation and their first Communion in grade two. Parents prepare their children for these sacraments using resources provided by the parish.

Sacrament of Confirmation:

Confirmation is conferred in grade 8 for baptized children who are in full communion (receiving Eucharist) at St. John Brebeuf. We begin preparation in the fall with an orientation meeting for candidates and parents.


