

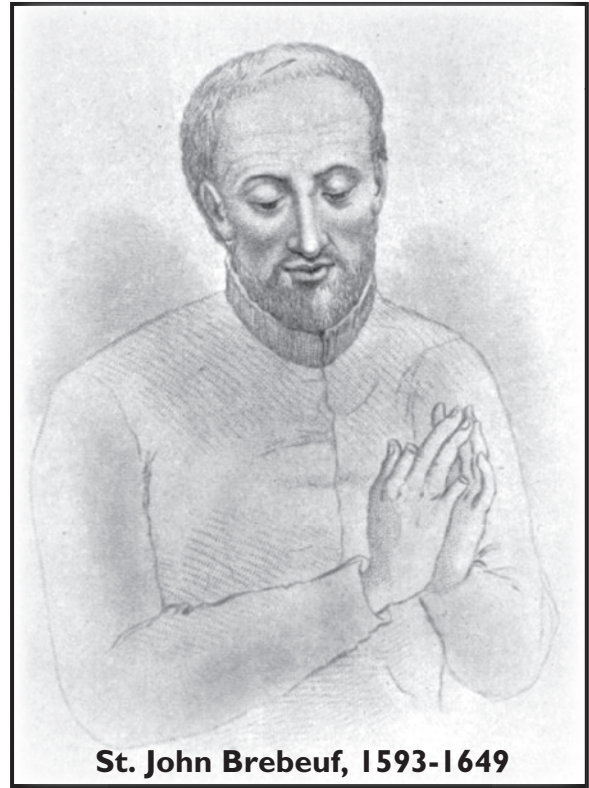

World Mission Sunday:

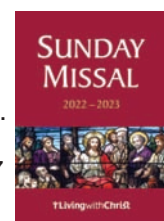

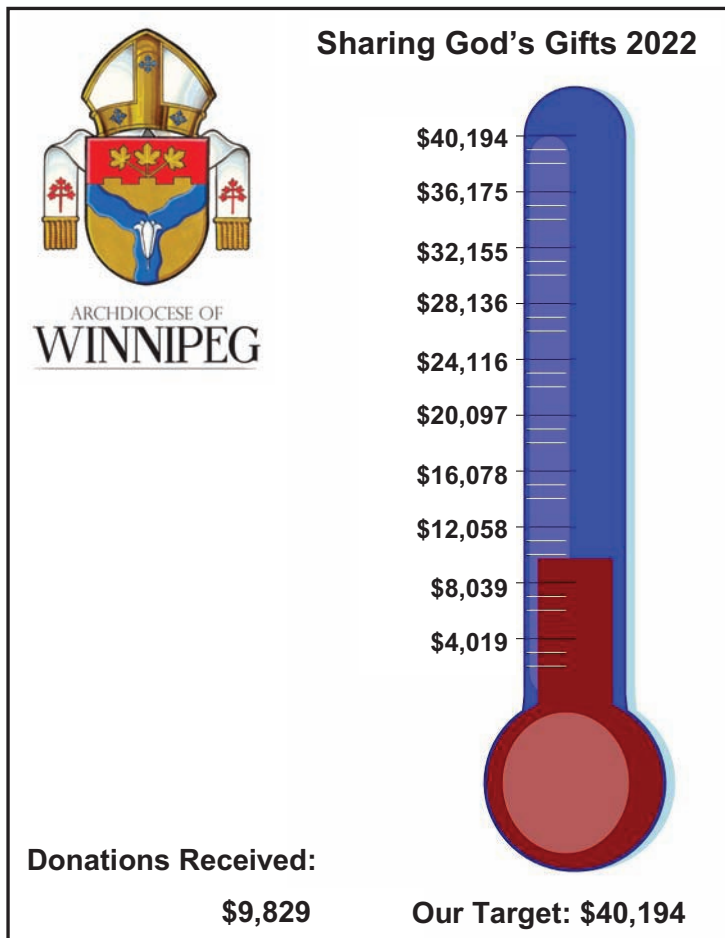



Diocesan World Youth Day Celebrations:
