



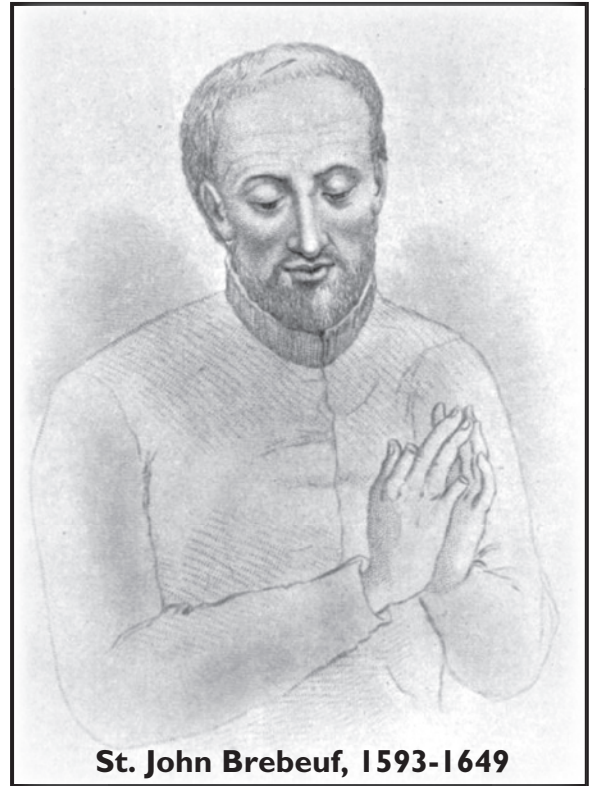

St. John Brebeuf Parish is looking for a Pastoral Assistant with strong organizational and communication skills. This is a part time, non-supervisory position with flexible hours.
