2 Maccabees 7.1-2, 7, 9-14++ *The King of the universe will raise us up to a resurrection of eternal life.* An ordinary Jewish family displays extraordinary faith. They look forward to eternal life with God.

R. I shall be satisfied, Lord, when I awake and behold your likeness.

2 THESSALONIANS 2.16—3.5 *May the Lord strengthen your hearts in every good work and word.* Paul prays that his converts will have the courage to live the gospel. He also asks for their prayers as Paul and his friends strive to spread the gospel.

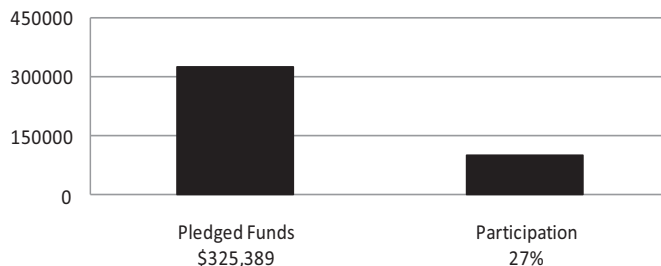
