



Refugee Support Request from St. Paul's College:

Earlier this year the Jesuit Refugee Service turned to St. Paul's College and asked for their help. The College has



A young family fled Afghanistan because they worked with the Jesuit Refugee Service. A little over a year ago, on August 14, 2021, the Taliban took over Bamyan Province, forcing this family, as well as the staff, including a Jesuit priest, to flee to the Baba Mountains, where they camped for a week and facilitated the escape of women out of the country. Eventually, out of fear of being in danger, the family relocated to Pakistan.

The College's target is to raise \$30,000 or more to support this family's safety in Winnipeg. So far, the College is at almost 50% of its goal.


