



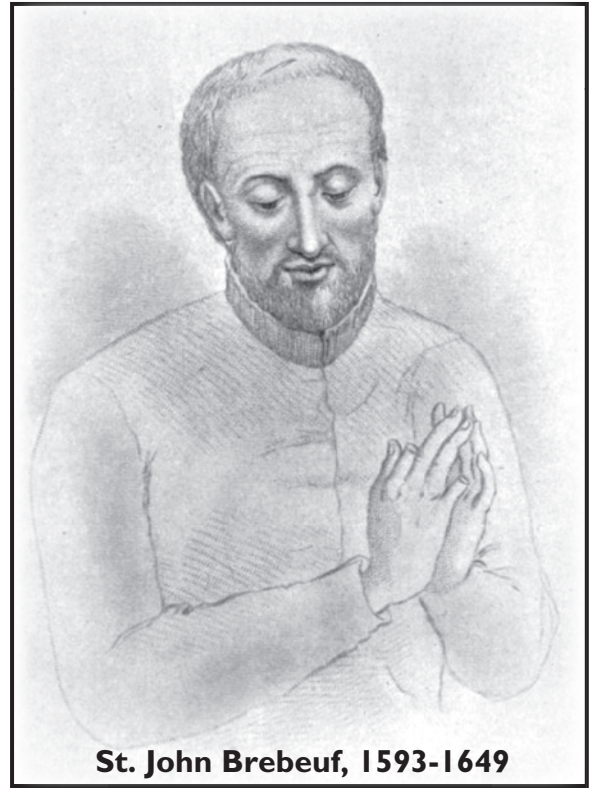

Annual 'Season of Creation' celebration:

The Season of Creation is an annual celebration to protect creation that started on September 1st and ends on the Feast of St. Francis on October 4th. In 2015, Pope Francis wrote "Laudato Si", an Encyclical letter pleading with us to take responsibility in the care of our world. His Holiness proclaimed September 1st, the first day of the "Season of Creation", to be the "World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation." He invites us to "weep with the earth, our common home" and to do something concrete in the healing of creation according to Creator's dream for all people and all creation. It is a day and a season to reaffirm our shared vocation as stewards of creation.



What can you do?

Especially in the warm weather months, strive to shop and eat locally. By purchasing food produced in our community, you are supporting nearby farmers and food producers, providing your family with fresh, nutritious food. Buying local also benefits our economy, and reduces the carbon footprint created through long distance plane or truck transportation.
