

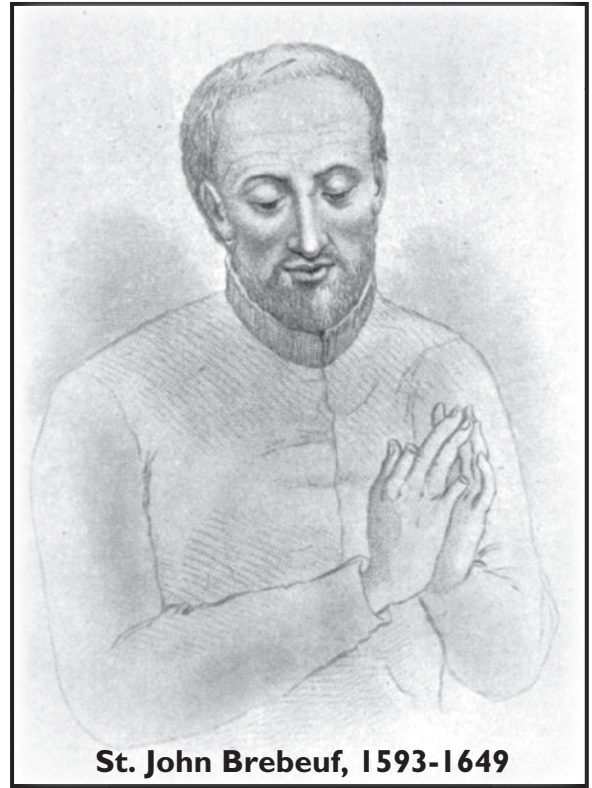

### Archbishop Exner Memorial Mass

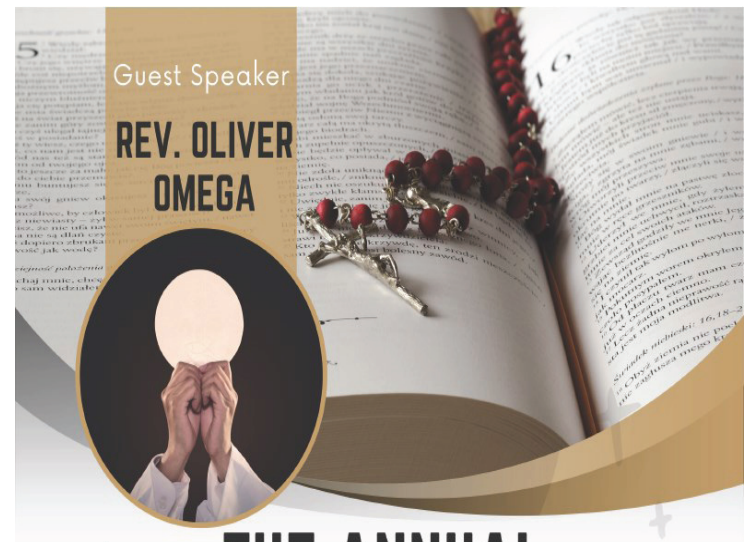
