

#### A Reminder that all protocols are still in place!

**Do not come to Mass if you are feeling ill**, particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.

Please sanitize your hands as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain physical distancing of six feet (2 meters) between people while in the building. The Use of Masks is required in the church.

Please leave your offering in the designated basket at the main church aisle when you enter the worship space.

Please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews. Unless you have come as a family unit, individual distancing of six feet (2 meters) within pews is required.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please exit as soon as Mass ends without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well-being of all.

#### Children's Catechism:

Offered once again online via Zoom due to ongoing pandemic restrictions for children in grades one to six.

#### Sacrament of 1st Reconciliation/1st Eucharist:

In the St. John Brebeuf community, children celebrate their first Reconciliation and their first Communion in grade two. Parents prepare their children for these sacraments using resources provided by the parish.

#### **Sacrament of Confirmation:**

Confirmation is conferred in grade 8 for baptized children who are in full communion (receiving Eucharist) at St. John Brebeuf. We begin preparation in the fall with an orientation meeting for candidates and parents.

Taking into consideration the current state of the pandemic, the general dispensation from Sunday Mass is now extended until Sunday, November 21, 2021.




#### **National Day for Truth and Reconciliation:**

Thursday, September 30, 2021, is Canada's National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. This day is meant to honour the victims and survivors of Canada's residential school system along with their families. This day is also a day that marks the importance of the relationships between the First Peoples of this land and the non-Indigenous People of Canada. It also presents an opportunity to listen to and reflect on the stories within our Indigenous and First Nations communities. Archbishop Gagnon would encourage everyone to take part in community-organized activities marking this first National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.

He will preside at Mass on September 30, 2021, at 11:30am, at St. Kateri Tekakwitha Parish in Winnipeg. The celebration will be live-streamed and will be made available through our Archdiocesan YouTube Channel (search, "Archdiocese of Winnipeg").

The Catholic Centre will be closed in observance of the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, as will the St. John Brebeuf Parish Office.
