Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please exit as soon as Mass ends without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well-being of all.


Your offering will be deducted from your bank account or credit card once per month. Forms and further information are available at www.sjbcommunity.ca.
