And so our Lenten journey is almost complete. Lent ends on Sundown Holy Thursday and the Sacred Triduum begins until Easter Sunday night. How has our Lenten journey been? Time to evaluate our practices of prayer,

fasting and almsgiving and see if they have truly contributed to our getting closer to Christ. Has my journey help me to conform myself to Christ, i.e., as St. Paul says dying to self in order that Christ might live in me.

Palm Sunday marks the triumphant entry of Jesus in Jerusalem. It is important to note that the same people who are throwing down their cloaks and waving palm branches and shouting Hosanna to the King are the same people that a few days later will be an angry mob screaming "Crucify Him! Crucify Him!" It is also important to note that we too are as easily swayed as the crowd. One moment we are committed to Jesus and desire to get close to him. The next moment we turn our backs on him and walk away.

As we look at our Lenten journey have we grown closer to Jesus or have we turned away? It is not too late! As Jesus said to the woman in last Sunday's Gospel: "Neither do I condemn you!" he says that same thing to us and is always ready, willing and able to start again. So let us ask pardon for the turning away and let us celebrate and build upon the turning towards! Our common Baptism gives us a universal call to holiness — let's use this Holy Week to grow in our holiness by getting closer to the One that does not condemn us!

PASCHAL FAST

Good Friday is a universal day of fast and abstinence from meat. The Church of God fasts on Good Friday and Holy Saturday to honour the suffering and death of our Lord Jesus, and to prepare to share more deeply in the joys of the Lord's Resurrection with uplifted and responsive hearts.

GOOD FRIDAY SPECIAL COLLECTION

During the Good Friday Liturgy, a special collection for the Needs of the Church in the Holy Land will be taken in all Churches throughout the world. This collection helps support future priests, the works of the Holy Land and the upkeep of the Holy Sites. Please give generously to respond to the needs of the Church in the land of Jesus.

VENERATION OF THE CROSS

After hearing the passion of Jesus on Good Friday, we approach the Cross to venerate it as the means of our salvation. The Cross remains the greatest symbol of Christianity which has been revered and honoured through the ages. As we venerate the Cross, we honour God who transformed this sign of death into a sign of forgiveness and life through the death of his son, Jesus. You may venerate by bowing, touching or kissing the Cross.

campaign, you will soon. The campaign intends to raise money for every parish in the Diocese of Hamilton and for shared ministries. Answers to a few Frequently Asked Questions are below, and a compilation of all questions are available throughout the campaign at oneheartonesoul.ca.

How do you determine the pledge amounts that families are asked to consider?

Ask amounts are based on a number of factors: planning study results, families' history of Parish support, input from church leadership, and the understanding that for this to be successful it will require sacrificial gifts. In other words, if the amount you are asked for is more than you anticipated, it generally means that you have been a generous supporter of your parish and/or the Diocese and is an indication of the challenge we face in reaching our goal. Through this campaign, we are asking everyone to consider supporting their Parish and the Diocese in a meaningful and sacrificial way and in a manner that works well for each family. It is not our intention to offend or embarrass anyone. The amount requested is NOT a demand or an expectation. It is an invitation to participate in this project at whatever level that is sacrificial and meaningful to you and your family. We will be grateful for any support you offer.

Are cash pledges the only kind of gifts?

Because many of the needs of the campaign will require immediate funding, gifts of cash and appreciated securities are generally sought. But trust and estate gifts are welcomed. Donors considering a planned gift should contact the diocesan development director, Francis Doyle, at 905-528-7988 to discuss the options available.


How can I make a gift or pledge to the campaign?
