GO-VAXX MOBILE VACCINE CLINIC



This initiative is a partnership between Metrolinx, local public health units and the Province and is a key part of Ontario's strategy, which focuses on community-based and easy-to-access settings for vaccinations. The GO-VAXX buses are fully accessible and heated. **On Friday, February 18th, the GO-VAXX bus will be in St. Mary's parking lot from 10 am – 6 pm.** The clinic can vaccinate anyone 5+ with an mRNA vaccine, for their first or second doses and third doses for those eligible. **Registration is not required**, though participants do need to bring some form of ID (OHIP health cards are encouraged).

PRE-AUTHORIZED GIVING
