### CR CORNER



Sr. Carla Mae's take on the Holy Trinity

While studying theology at Aquinas institute of theology in St Louis Missouri, Sr. Carla Mae Streeter, OP offered a wonderful image that helped me better understand the Holy Trinity.

To the classes surprise, she's simply invited us to take a good long meditative look at a crucifix. As we began our meditation she asked us if we were able to see the source of love (God), moving through the perfect mediator (Jesus), and the mysterious outpouring of love for everyone (Holy Spirit). When pondering the outpouring of love we all noticed that the wound in Christ's side became that image of how abundant, self-sacrificing, and generous God's love really is. It is through Christ's brokenness and many of us saw this in a powerful way.

There are many images to explore when trying to gain a deeper appreciation of how the presence of love exists in relationship and reaches out to us. As we ponder the mystery of the Holy Trinity this Sunday my prayer is that we will all take time in front of a crucifix and allow the transforming power of love to reveal itself in a relationship between the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Never in relationship just for themselves but for the sake of sharing their love with all of humanity. May the Holy Trinity continue to reach us all in a mysterious way and model for us what it is to share the love that we find in relationship with everyone we encounter - especially during times when we, like Christ, might feel broken.
