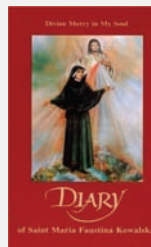

ANNUAL MISSION CO-OPERATIVE

Next weekend, June 25/26. Sr. Vera Komar of the Congregation of the Sisters of The Holy Trinity will speak about their Mission in Mexico. The Sisters of The Holy Trinity was founded in Madrid, Spain in 1885 by Father Francisco Mendez and by Mother Mariana Allsopp. Their mission was to help girls and young adults by offering them "A door that is always open", to help free them from the slavery of prostitution, drugs and dramatic experiences of sexual and physical abuse and poverty. They have 6 Homes in Mexico for girls from the ages of 12 - 20's. Along with the ministry of the Mission Homes they also visit women in the prison, the homeless on the streets and go into the Mountains visiting the natives of Oaxaca. The collection for Mission Co-Op will take place the following weekend, July 2/3. Envelopes are in your boxed sets.

SVDP, ST. MARY'S CONFERENCE ANNUAL UPDATE

Monthly food hamper and voucher requests unexpectedly doubled in late Fall, 2015 and Winter, 2016. Thankfully, our Parish donations remained strong at approximately \$1,350 per month with increases at Christmas and Easter.

2015 saw 580 adults and 90 children receive food hamper and voucher support. Additionally, 14 vouchers for clothing and furniture were distributed to those in exceptional circumstances resulting from events such as fire, theft, bedbug infestation or eviction.

St. Mary's SVdeP Conference is a highly trusted and needed resource to our neighbours living in poverty. Our Parish's monthly donations are essential in assisting many of our neighbours who constantly juggle to pay for their shelter, utilities and food.

Please know every donation is gratefully received and distributed almost immediately by devoted volunteers with care and respect. SVdeP patrons consistently express their heartfelt thanks and appreciation to our Parish for its compassionate care.

We are hopeful donations over the summer months and through these months of road construction disruptions will remain steady so that our Parish can continue to help our impoverished neighbours.
