The Sisters of The Holy Trinity was founded in Madrid, Spain in 1885 by Father Francisco Mendez and by Mother Mariana Allsopp. Their mission was to help girls and young adults by offering them "A door that is always open", to help free them from the slavery of prostitution, drugs and dramatic experiences of sexual and physical abuse and poverty. They have 6 Homes in Mexico for girls from the ages of 12 - 20's. Along with the ministry of the Mission Homes they also visit women in the prison, the homeless on the streets and go into the Mountains visiting the natives of Oaxaca.
