**TRADITIONAL TRIDENTINE LATIN MASS**

The Traditional Tridentine Latin Mass will be offered here at St. Mary's Parish, on Sundays at 3 pm, beginning July 1<sup>st</sup>.

The Traditional Latin Mass of today is essentially unchanged since the Council of Trent, 500 years ago. Some elements are derived from Jewish customs dating back to pre-Apostolic times, and other parts were developed by Church Fathers and various Saints and Popes. Pope Saint Gregory the Great instituted the Greek Kyrie Eleison and Sacred Chant during his reign.

While the priest prays most of the Mass in Latin, he reads the Epistle and Gospel in English, as well as preaches his sermon in English. A missal is provided that contains the prayers of the Mass in both Latin and English to assist you. Confession is available each Sunday 30 minutes before the Mass.

The traditional Latin Tridentine Mass has been described as "the most beautiful thing this side of heaven." The focus and reverence of the Mass are truly up-lifting and sublime to part-take in. The Traditional Latin Mass community welcomes all those interested in joining in the offering of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass in this age old form.

When your children act up, suppress your anger and help them to understand what is really going on; you will find both of you will be smiling more often

**MARRIAGE TIP OF THE MONTH**

Expressing gratitude to those we love goes a long way to making them feel appreciated, but as Michele Weiner-Davis (The Divorce Busting Center) pointed out in her recent blog, negativity bias, which scientists refer to as a tendency to be more sensitive to negative stimuli, often causes relationship problems. This bias makes it easy for us to slip into the habit of remarking on anything that is wrong or negative but forgetting to express the good we experience and feel. We can help overcome this natural bias by being purposeful in our interactions: express appreciation often, say thank you frequently and remember to tell your spouse what you love about your relationship. Doing a frequent check-up is a sure way to ensure you are more positive than negative, which will be reflected in the positive feelings in your marriage.
