Dream Big. Stay Focused. Trust in God.

It's not often that we refer to Abraham and Sarah as "dreamers." But they were. Dreaming of a future that would be prosperous with land and many offspring. To have these was to be

blessed by God. To be blessed by God meant that you were obedient to God's ways. Through the gift of hindsight we can see how they surrendered their dreams to God in prayer and how God delivered on what was promised. The risks they took paid off in the end!

All too often we can live without surrendering our dreams to God. Or worse yet, we may despair and stop dreaming altogether. If our readings reveal anything about dreaming this Sunday it is that we are all "dreamers" in a way. We were meant to have them and long for our dreams to become a reality.
