SORROW TO JOY!

We continue to look on with sadness and disbelief at the images and stories coming out of Ukraine. The senseless violence against families can be disheartening and sometimes even overwhelming. Yet even in this dark hour, there are glimmers of Christ's love for the world. I came across the story of a 12-year old boy named Gabriel with a passion for woodworking. Gabriel wanted a new mountain bike so badly, he decided to make some hand-crafted wooden bowls and sell them to raise money. Once his dad started posting to social media, Gabriel quickly gained a large following, and was receiving more orders than he could handle. That's when he had a change of heart: he decided to carve one special bowl and raffle it off in support of Ukraine, raising more than \$300,000. Friends, the kindness of St. Joseph the carpenter is alive and well in stories like that of Gabriel!

This past Wednesday, we offered a special rosary after the noon Mass for peace in Ukraine, as Pope Francis has called for an Easter season truce between the warring nations. May God protect all affected by the conflict.


