The Gratitude: A Disposition for Everyone

Samaritans were people who were often seen as living outside of the organized religions of Jesus' day. Sadducees, Pharisees, and Zealots

alike had a way of living that had well defined modes of operation that distinguished themselves from everyone else. So when a Samaritan is upheld in Luke's gospel as the only one from the ten people healed to return to Jesus to give thanks, there is a theological point being made. Namely, that Christ came for everyone (even Samaritans!) and it is not always predictable who will be among those to say thank you. Extending a common courtesy of gratitude while giving praise to God.

As we celebrate Thanksgiving may the Gospel remind us to be among those who give thanks to God for the many blessings we have and continue to receive. May we be eager and humble enough to acknowledge that we are reliant upon God's ability to provide for our needs out of love for all humanity. And when given a chance, let's extend the love we share to someone new whom we too see as someone to whom Christ desires to encounter and in some way heal.


