#### **WORLD MISSION SUNDAY**

Next weekend, October 21<sup>st</sup>/22<sup>nd</sup>. During this time, we celebrate who we are as Christians: missionary disciples. It's a time of prayer. We are also invited to look beyond our local Church in Canada and assist through financial gifts, the missionary work needed in the young dioceses in many developing countries. An example of this work is providing health care centres, building schools, and construction of convents and presbyteries. Please pray for the missions and show generosity on World Mission Sunday.

#### ALL SAINT'S DAY

This day honours all the known and unknown saints of the Church and provides us with an opportunity to reflect on the nature of sainthood and to celebrate the exemplary faithfulness of holy men and women whose lives and deeds continue to inspire us. It is first found in the Western Church in 8<sup>th</sup> century England and called Allhallows. "Hallowed" from the Old English, is the word for "holy". Thus "Hallowe'en" is from "Allhallows even", or "the eve of All Saints." On Wednesday, November 1<sup>st</sup>, the Relics of St. Mary's will be available for private prayer after 8 am Mass until 1:00 pm. This is a beautiful time to become more acquainted with the patrons of our parish.

#### **ALL SOULS DAY**

Thursday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>. In the 7<sup>th</sup> century, some monastic foundations reserved this day to pray for deceased members and benefactors. In 998 a tradition was established of keeping, "with joyous affection, the memory of all the faithful departed who have lived from the beginning of the world until the end." By the 14<sup>th</sup> century, the commemoration was universally accepted in the Latin Church. Our Relics will be available for private prayer following the 12:10 pm Mass until 2 pm.

#### PLENARY INDULGENCE

(the FULL forgiveness of the temporal punishment, due to sin, of the soul in Purgatory being prayed for). Every day from **November 1**<sup>st</sup> **through 8**<sup>th</sup> you may gain a Plenary Indulgence and offer it, once each day, for one deceased person. You must be in the state of grace (Confession and Communion), attend Church or visit the cemetery and say for the intention of the Holy Father: one Our Father, one Hail Mary and one Glory Be.
