**GRADE 8 FESTIVAL 2015**

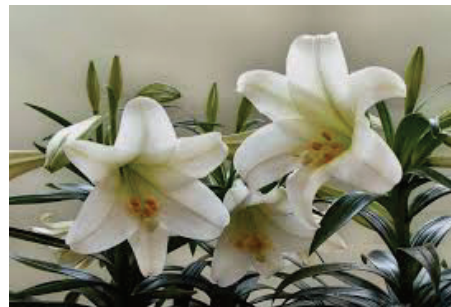
