Jesus' words in today's Gospel ring true in our very day. He says to the crowd: "Take care. Be on guard against all kinds of greed; for one's life does not consist in the abundance of possessions." How might we grow in awareness or greater consciousness of where and what God is asking of us? Perhaps a practice of daily discernment at the end of the day might be of some assistance. You will be amazed if you do this on a regular basis that your relationships to God, self and others will move you to ongoing conversion. Below is a brief Awareness Process that might help you for end-of-the-day discernment:

- Ask God to help you see the past day through God's eyes and ask for enlightenment
- 2. Recall the key events of the day: what were the high points? Low points? What was my response in each case?
- 3. Recall your prayer from the morning: how might it relate to the day's events?
- 4. What might God be saying to me from the gifts/events of today?
- 5. Express gratitude for the gifts you have received, or sorrow for a lack of response.
- 6. Where do I sense God is calling me from here?
- Is there any grace that I feel God is inviting me to? i.e. surrender to God's will, asking for forgiveness, peace of mind and heart and spirit, charity, to unconditional love, etc...
