According to tradition, he was arrested and imprisoned after being caught marrying Christian couples and helping his fellow Christians who were being persecuted. While imprisoned, St. Valentine made an effort to convert the Emperor. Soon afterward, he was martyred February 14th 269 and his Feast Day was celebrated for the first time by the Church in 496.
