

Co-ordinators of Why Catholic Process Required!

As you know, we just finished a 3 year commitment to the ARISE process. This year there is another process being offered entitled WHY CATHOLIC? Why Catholic is implemented just like ARISE was. In order to oversee the Why Catholic process, a Team Coordinator is needed to facilitate the work of the Team and reports to the Pastoral Team and Parish Pastoral Council. The Team Coordinator assumes responsibility for successfully guiding team leaders in the fulfillment of its roles and responsibilities. At least 6 volunteers are required to form a viable team with the addition of several volunteers to lead small faith community groups. If you are interested in coordinating this process by taking full responsibility for recruiting leaders, attending 10 Workshops for training, and overseeing all of the logistics for implementation of the Why Catholic Process, please see Sister Linda.


