Dear Parishioners of Most Precious Blood Parish,

Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Baptism of Our Lord. This brings to an end the season of Christmas. The Church recalls Our Lord's second manifestation or epiphany which occurred on the occasion of His baptism in the Jordan. Jesus descended into the River to sanctify its waters and to give them the power to beget sons of God. The event takes on the importance of a second creation in which the entire Trinity intervenes. In submitting Himself humbly to the baptism of St. John the Baptist, however, Christ provided the example for the rest of us.
