Dear Parishioners,

With a Christian life, we can't run away or hide from God's Will, Pope Francis said. Rather, we must continuously show up - speaking to God in prayer and striving to do his Will.

"The Christian life is this: Here I am, here I am, I continue to do the Will of the Lord."

Today's liturgy invites us to reflect and ask ourselves: 'How am I doing at responding to the Lord's call? Do I hide like Adam in the Garden of Eden, not responding? Do I run away like Jonah, or look the other way like the Levite and the priest when they saw the man wounded and beaten by strangers?

Sometimes, in the course of our lives, we may get angry with God, Francis noted. But this can also be a way to pray: as our Father, "he likes to discuss with us," the Pope said. Even if you are angry, still pray - tell God how you feel.

This is just another way of responding to God, of saying "here I am," he said.

The alternative, Pope Francis said, is to hide, run away, pretend, or look the other way.

"Each of us can answer: How is my 'Here I am' to the Lord, doing his Will in my life? How is it? May the Holy Spirit give us the grace to find the answer."

May we take the words of Pope Francis and reflect on them as we carry on day by day with our Catholic Christian lives.
