40 DAYS FOR LIFE

40 Days for Life is a peaceful, focused campaign that generates measurable life-saving results. So far, 40 Days for Life campaigns have been conducted in 607 communities in 32 nations. More than 11,165 children have been reported as saved from abortion. 127 abortion workers have quit and 64 abortion centers have closed. In each city, hundreds—more than 1,000 in some cases are getting involved with local life-saving efforts for the first time.
