High School Conference- Toronto

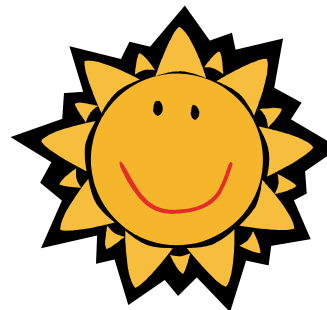
